Assignment #1: Read the book, *Because of Winn Dixie*, by Kate Di Camillo. (BL: 3.9; ISBN: 9780439250726). Complete the graphic organizer for rising 3rd grade students. Bring it to class on the first day of school. This will help you to be ready to discuss the book in class and complete an in-class project. A quiz grade will be given for completion of the graphic organizer fully and neatly.

Assignment #2: Over the summer, keep a reading log of the books you read to reach 750 minutes before school begins.
